

HAND TIGHTENING OF HARDWARE IS RECOMMENDED!

Due to natural expansion and contraction of material, over-tightening may cause stress cracks. DO NOT use power tools, large wrenches or rachets to tighten or install hardware. When installing hardware, hand tighten then "backoff" one quarter turn.



YES: Use bolt or screw that is smaller than diameter of hole to allow the material to expand and contract.



NO: If the bolt or screw is too tight the plastic has no room to expand and will thus cause cracking.
